This Guideline replaces DACE Guideline No. 56 (Rev.), titled *A-G" Approved Courses in Adult Education*, issued on March 17, 2014.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide procedures for uniformly granting credit to students who take adult education courses and to equitably assign credit for equivalent adult education courses.

II. CHANGES

The information has been revised to reflect current Division of Adult and Career Education (DACE) school courses that are aligned to the California Content Standards, meet University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) "A-G" requirements.

Changes consist of the addition of a Financial Literacy course and removal of Biology 1, Biology 2, Spanish 1A, 1B courses.

III. GUIDELINES

a. INTRODUCTION

Under special circumstances, senior high school students may attend classes intended primarily for adults. According to Section 52500 of the Education Code: "Adult schools and evening senior high schools shall consist of classes for adults. Minors may be admitted to those classes pursuant to Board policy." Senior high school students may enroll in adult education courses when they demonstrate a need for academic remediation or completion of high school credit deficiencies and have received prior approval from their school administrator or counselor.

b. ENROLLMENT CRITERIA, GRADES, AND EQUIVALENT COURSES

Enrollment in any DACE course is contingent upon the approval of the senior high school administrator or counselor, and the adult school counselor. A concurrent student

enrolled in a DACE course who has not completed the course by the end of a grading period will not receive a grade. When all work for an adult school course taken by a concurrently enrolled high school student is completed, and a grade has been issued by the adult school teacher, then the course grade and appropriate high school credits earned are automatically recorded in the student's electronic transcript in the high school student information system (MiSiS).

Attachment A lists active Division courses that have been approved by the University of California to satisfy UC subject requirements for freshman admission and the equivalent academic courses for senior high school diploma credit (Attachment A).
